VISITED OBJECTS:

BATU BULAN is the home of stone carving, carved by the local professional hand. Traditionally, these sculptures, made of soft volcanic rock, were used as temple ornaments and decorative pieces.

CELUK is known as the “silver village” for its jewelry production. Artisans here create silver and gold jewelry and handicrafts in their homes and workshops as they have for centuries.

MAS is a village of art with a focus on carving of wood sculptures with characteristic synergy of humanism and naturalism.

TEGALALANG This valley of rice paddies, located north of Ubud has some jaw-dropping views and is a great area to wander around. Explore all the different levels, have a swing, and of course a lot of photos. Along the street there are many touristy shops all with handmade goods and souvenirs. There are also heaps of cafes scattered across the main touristy section.

UBUD MARKET is a one stop place to shop for souvenirs to take home. The items sold are very unique because they are typically Balinese, and some are unavailable elsewhere.
