

FLORES TOUR 2020

THE HIGHLIGHT OF FLORES

TYPE: PRIVATE TOUR

MIN BOOKING: 2 PEOPLE

DURATION: 8DAYS

MEETING POINT – TIME: LABUAN BAJO AIRPORT (flight arrival before 11.00) or HOTEL (at 08.00)

ENDING POINT – TIME: MAUMERE or ENDE AIRPORT (any time)

DAY 1

RINCA ISLAND is a rough and tumble little place full of wildlife, poisonous snakes, and of course, the Komodo dragon. We will do 2 hours afternoon trekking to explore the island and see the wild Komodo Dragons.

KALONG KOMODO a bay in Komodo National Park with calm sea. We will stay overnight on board around the bay.

DAY 2

KOMODO ISLAND is particularly notable as the habitat of the Komodo dragon, the largest lizard on Earth. The island is made up of rusty-red volcanic hills, savannah and forests. We will do 2 hours afternoon trekking to explore the island and see the wild Komodo Dragons

PINK BEACH KOMODO is located in Komodo National Park with pink color of sand, serenity ambiance, panoramic view and beautiful underwater for snorkeling.

BIDADARI ISLAND is a beautiful island with white sandy beach and clear seawater, ideally good for diving as well as snorkeling. It offers The amazing underwater lives with colorful fishes as well as corals

DAY 3 LABUAN BAJO – RUTENG

CUNCA WULANG CANYON, located 30km east of Labuan Bajo and nestled in a tropical rainforest setting, is one of Flores most striking spots for outdoor activities. Impressive waterfalls cascade into beautiful, fresh-water pools and lead into a series of smaller waterfalls and rivers a few kilometers downstream.

CANCAR is a unique tourist spot offers stunning landscape. The farmers grow the rice in such peculiar formation, making a unique shape as it consists of several farms and combines into a shape of the spider's net.

RUTENG PU'U VILLAGE is a traditional village with traditional compang in the centre of village for ceremonies and rituals. A compang is a round platform made of stone and is surrounded by a circle of stones and traditional houses. It is used for sacrificial offerings during traditional ceremonies.

RUTENG is located at the foot of a high mountain range. It offers a pleasant, cool climate for relaxing.

DAY 4 RUTENG – BAJAWA

LIANG BUA CAVE is a huge cave in a limestone hill of Manggarai District in Flores. The size is 50 meters long, 40 meters wide, and 25 meters tall. This limestone cave has yielded some of the most important finds in modern anthropology. The remains of two "hobbit" people were found here in 2003. There is a small museum on site and while the displays are only in Indonesian, they're easy to make sense of. The cave itself, hobbits aside, is impressive and the scenery along the way is just beautiful.

RANAMESE LAKE is situated in the middle of forest, surrounded by a lush vegetation of mosses, scrubs, tropical woods, and water plants. The climate is comfortably fresh. Its calm and clear water makes it easy to spot freshwater fish.

AIMERE is the main place in Flores that produces the traditional boozy beverage known as 'arak' (wine). As tradition dictates, visitors to the village will be served and fresh Lontar Palm juice which is sweet and slightly effervescent.

BAJAWA is a small charming town located in the middle of the Florinese highlands. It is surrounded by forest-covered mountains with a pleasant climate.

DAY 5 BAJAWA

BENA a community that is situated at the foot of Mount Inerie. It has impressive stone formations and ancestral shrines, as well as traditional houses. Bena offers an awesome sight, the megalithic formations in the village center.

SOA HOT SPRING offers warm water that flows from a river under the shade of coconut trees. Walk further to a canyon with beautiful drop-offs that almost look like little waterfalls.

DAY 6 BAJAWA – MONI

BLUE STONE BEACH on the central south coast of Flores is both gorgeous and a geological oddity. This black volcanic sand beach is strewn with blue, green, red and yellow stones as far as the eye can see.

SOEKARNO MUSEUM ENDE offers a sneak-peek into the imprinting stage of life of the nation's most characteristic leadership figure and time travel through the nation's past era of independence struggle within an already shaking colonial power.

DETUSUKO A village in a valley blanketed with rice fields, located halfway between Ende and Moni is a misty, cool hill town with amazing rice field scenery.

WOLOGAI VILLAGE is one of the few villages in the Ende district with well-maintained houses built in the traditional Lionese architectural style.

NDUA RIA Take a visit to a traditional fruit and vegetable market all freshly pick from the local farms.

MONI VILLAGE a small village as a gateway to the Three Color Lake, Kelimutu Volcano.

DAY 7 MONI – MAUMERE

KALIMUTU THREE COLOR LAKE Mount Kelimutu, with its three colored crater lakes, is probably the most amazing natural phenomenon in Flores. There are local named designated to each lakes ; Tiwu ata Mbupu (Lake of Old People) which is usually blue and on the westernmost of the three lakes. The other two lakes are Tiwu Nuwa Muri Koo Fai (Lake of Young Men and Maidens) for the green colored lakes and Tiwu Ata Polo (Bewitched or Enchanted Lake) for the red colored lakes and only separated by a crater wall.

Early morning start to climb the volcano. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of sun rise and three Color Lake from the bank of the crater.

JOPU Traditional Village is yet another tribal village that is beautifully preserved. The woodcarvings on the doorways, benches, and walls are particularly interesting here. The tribe living here is called Lio.

KOKA BEACH is an exotic beach with ti's white sands coastwise. White and fine sand stretch along the coastline and that assure us that Koka Beach become a hidden paradise.

MAUMERE is a sea port located in the East of Flores.

DAY 8 MAUMERE - AIRPORT

Free program and drive to Maumere airport for the next destination.
