WONDERFUL FLORES LAND TOUR 2

TYPE: PRIVATE TOUR

MIN BOOKING: 2 PEOPLE

DURATION: 4DAYS

MEETING POINT – TIME: MAUMERE or ENDE AIRPORT (flight arrival before 12.00) or HOTEL (at 08.00)

ENDING POINT – TIME: LABUAN BAJO AIRPORT (flight departure after 17.00) or HOTEL

DAY 1 MAUMERE – MONI

KOKA BEACH is an exotic beach with ti's white sands coastwise. White and fine sand stretch along the coastline and that assure us that Koka Beach become a hidden paradise.

MONI VILLAGE a small village as a gateway to the Three Color Lake, Kelimutu Volcano.

DAY 2 MONI – BAJAWA

KALIMUTU THREE COLOR LAKE Mount Kelimutu, with its three colored crater lakes, is probably the most amazing natural phenomenon in Flores. There are local named designated to each lakes ; Tiwu ata Mbupu (Lake of Old People) which is usually blue and on the westernmost of the three lakes. The other two lakes are Tiwu Nuwa Muri Koo Fai (Lake of Young Men and Maidens) for the green colored lakes and Tiwu Ata Polo (Bewitched or Enchanted Lake) for the red colored lakes and only separated by a crater wall.

Early morning start to climb the volcano. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of sun rise and three Color Lake from the bank of the crater.

NDUA RIA Take a visit to a traditional fruit and vegetable market all freshly pick from the local farms.

WOLOGAI VILLAGE is one of the few villages in the Ende district with well-maintained houses built in the traditional Lionese architectural style.

BLUE STONE BEACH on the central south coast of Flores is both gorgeous and a geological oddity. This black volcanic sand beach is strewn with blue, green, red and yellow stones as far as the eye can see.

SOA HOT SPRING offers warm water that flows from a river under the shade of coconut trees. Walk further to a canyon with beautiful drop-offs that almost look like little waterfalls.

BAJAWA is a small charming town located in the middle of the Florinese highlands. It is surrounded by forest-covered mountains with a pleasant climate.

DAY 3 BAJAWA – RUTENG

BENA a community that is situated at the foot of Mount Inerie. It has impressive stone formations and ancestral shrines, as well as traditional houses. Bena offers an awesome sight, the megalithic formations in the village center.

AIMERE is the main place in Flores that produces the traditional boozy beverage known as 'arak' (wine). As tradition dictates, visitors to the village will be served and fresh Lontar Palm juice which is sweet and slightly effervescent.

RANAMESE LAKE is situated in the middle of forest, surrounded by a lush vegetation of mosses, scrubs, tropical woods, and water plants. The climate is comfortably fresh. Its calm and clear water makes it easy to spot freshwater fish.

LIANG BUA CAVE is a huge cave in a limestone hill of Manggarai District in Flores. The size is 50 meters long, 40 meters wide, and 25 meters tall. This limestone cave has yielded some of the most important finds in modern anthropology. The remains of two “hobbit” people were found here in 2003. There is a small museum on site and while the displays are only in Indonesian, they’re easy to make sense of. The cave itself, hobbits aside, is impressive and the scenery along the way is just beautiful.

RUTENG is located at the foot of a high mountain range. It offers a pleasant, cool climate for relaxing.

DAY 4 RUTENG – LABUAN BAJO

RUTENG PU’U VILLAGE is a traditional village with traditional compang in the centre of village for ceremonies and rituals. A compang is a round platform made of stone and is surrounded by a circle of stones and traditional houses. It is used for sacrificial offerings during traditional ceremonies.

CANCAR is a unique tourist spot offers stunning landscape. The farmers grow the rice in such peculiar formation, making a unique shape as it consists of several farms and combines into a shape of the spider’s net.

MELO VIEW POINT has a spectacular panorama view stretching from Labuan Bajo to the island of Komodo National Park. It offers fresh mountain air since it is located on the side of Mount Mbeliling.
