THE GREAT OF FLORES LAND TOUR

MEETING POINT – TIME: LABUAN BAJO HOTEL (at 07.00)

ENDING POINT – TIME: LABUAN BAJO AIRPORT (flight departure after 17.00) or HOTEL

DAY 1 LABUAN BAJO – BAJAWA

MELO VIEW POINT has a spectacular panorama view stretching from Labuan Bajo to the island of Komodo National Park. The village also offers fresh mountain air since it is located on the side of Mount Mbeliling.

CANCAR is a unique tourist spot offers stunning landscape. The farmers grow the rice in such peculiar formation, making a unique shape as it consists of several farms and combines into a shape of the spider's net.

RANAMESE LAKE is situated in the middle of forest, surrounded by a lush vegetation of mosses, scrubs, tropical woods, and water plants. The climate is comfortably fresh. Its calm and clear water makes it easy to spot freshwater fish.

BAJAWA is a small charming town located in the middle of the Florinese highlands. It is surrounded by forest-covered mountains with a pleasant climate.

DAY 2 BAJAWA – MONI

BENA a community that is situated at the foot of Mount Inerie. It has impressive stone formations and ancestral shrines, as well as traditional houses. Bena offers an awesome sight, the megalithic formations in the village center.

BLUE STONE BEACH on the central south coast of Flores is both gorgeous and a geological oddity. This black volcanic sand beach is strewn with blue, green, red and yellow stones as far as the eye can see.

DETUSUKO A village in a valley blanketed with rice fields, located halfway between Ende and Moni is a misty, cool hill town with amazing rice field scenery.

WOLOGAI VILLAGE is one of the few villages in the Ende district with well-maintained houses built in the traditional Lionese architectural style.

NDUA RIA Take a visit to a traditional fruit and vegetable market all freshly pick from the local farms.

MONI VILLAGE a small village as a gateway to the Three Color Lake, Kelimutu Volcano.

DAY 3 MONI – RIUNG

KALIMUTU THREE COLOR LAKE Mount Kelimutu, with its three colored crater lakes, is probably the most amazing natural phenomenon in Flores. There are local named designated to each lakes ; Tiwu ata Mbupu (Lake of Old People) which is usually blue and on the westernmost of the three lakes. The other two lakes are Tiwu Nuwa Muri Koo Fai (Lake of Young Men and Maidens) for the green colored lakes and Tiwu Ata Polo (Bewitched or Enchanted Lake) for the red colored lakes and only separated by a crater wall.

Early morning start to climb the volcano. Enjoy the beautiful scenery of sun rise and three Color Lake from the bank of the crater.

RIUNG on Flores Island is famed for being home to the remarkable 17 Islands National Park. The small-time fishing town of Riung is perched along the quiet and relatively dry northern coast of Flores.

DAY 4 RIUNG

17 ISLANDS SNORKELING TOUR island-hopping in smallish fishing vessels from one white-sand tropical paradise to another. Pristine beaches, azure waters, & enchanting views welcomed us at every turn. And with the islands in such close proximity of one another, it allowed us to maximize our time enjoying them, rather than spending it on the boat. The area is also perfect for snorkeling, with the waters boasting an abundance of coral & marine life. As it is only a day trip, we won't have enough time to visit all islands. We only visit 3 most beautiful islands in this national park. (*snorkeling gear is provided by customer*).

DAY 5 RIUNG – RUTENG

SOA HOT SPRING offers warm water that flows from a river under the shade of coconut trees. Walk further to a canyon with beautiful drop-offs that almost look like little waterfalls.

AIMERE is the main place in Flores that produces the traditional boozy beverage known as 'arak' (wine). As tradition dictates, visitors to the village will be served and fresh Lontar Palm juice which is sweet and slightly effervescent.

RUTENG is located at the foot of a high mountain range. It offers a pleasant, cool climate for relaxing.

DAY 6 RUTENG – LABUAN BAJO

GOLO CURU HILL is a hilltop location in the city of Ruteng, the capital city of Manggarai district. Judging from what he said, Golo is a hill / village, while Curu could mean the shuttle or the name of a tribe that once inhabited this hill. Golo Curu is a small hill there is the "Cave of Mary" is a place of pilgrimage and prayer of Christians. The perfect place to see the beauty of the city of Ruteng.

RUTENG PU'U VILLAGE is a traditional village with traditional compang in the centre of village for ceremonies and rituals. A compang is a round platform made of stone and is surrounded by a circle of stones and traditional houses. It is used for sacrificial offerings during traditional ceremonies.

LEMBOR VILLAGE offers a serene and comfortable atmosphere as its scenery of paddy fields to tourists.

Lembor is a fertile village and it has a high rainfall and tropical climate. Most parts of Lembor Village are covered by farms. That means many villagers work as a farmer and they live peacefully in traditional ways.
